Summary:

Truck 85 is a 2000 Marion Body works build, 105' Aerial Innovations rear mount ladder truck. It is considered a Quint which means that it has a water pump, water tank and hose carried on board.

In late 2012 the Board of Directors agreed to purchase a new truck based on the research and maintenance review conducted by an internal committee. The new Sutphen Aerial Platform truck went into service July 1st at 10:00 AM.

A specifications sheet and announcement to sell 8591 was distributed to over 5 used fire apparatus sales companies as well as the local fire departments. After 30 days no bids were received.

Many companies were contacted that take used apparatus and put it on consignment for sale. They typically take a percentage for the effort to sell the apparatus, this percentage varies from company to company. EDHFD has used Fire Trucks Plus to sell an engine many years ago.

Fiscal Impact:

Estimated revenue \$125,000 - \$175,000

Recommendation:

Enter into a contract with a staff approved used Fire Apparatus company to maximize sales revenue from 8591. Place 8591 on consignment and sell it at the highest possible price.
