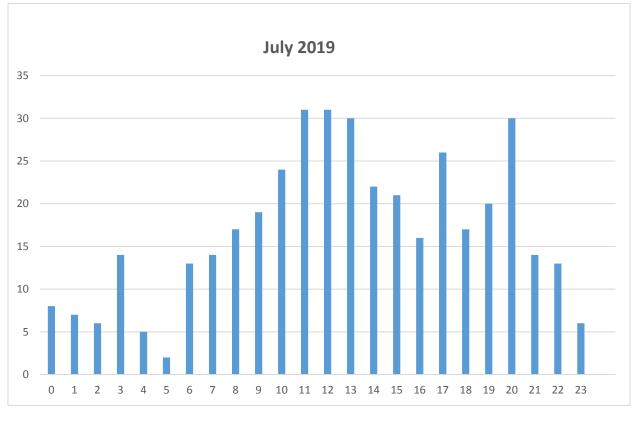

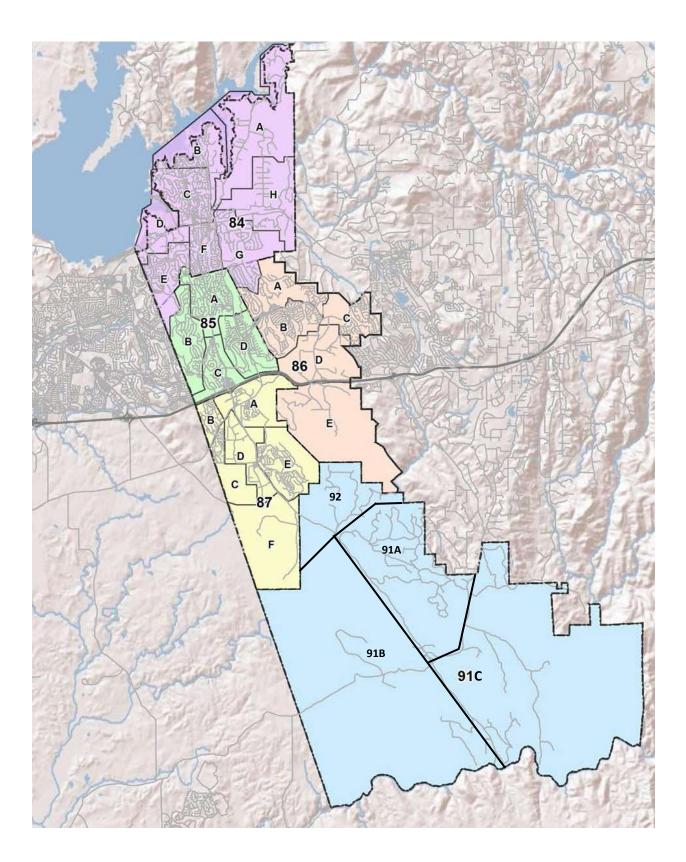

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-07 EL DORADO HILLS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO PERFORM AND CHARGE FOR RESIDENTIAL SPRINKLER INSPECTIONS

WHEREAS, the El Dorado Hills County Water District Board (Fire Department) has the authority pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 13146 and Section 1.8.3 of the California Residential Building Code to perform inspections of residential sprinklers within the District's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, residential sprinkler inspections have previously been completed by the El Dorado County Planning and Building Department; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado Hills County Water District (Fire Department) has notified the El Dorado County Planning and Building Department of its intent to begin reviewing residential fire sprinkler plans and conducting inspection of those systems within its jurisdiction and Has requested County cooperation in transitioning the responsibility therefor; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado Hills County Water District will charge a fee for this service consistent with its current prevention fee rate schedule; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the District resolves as follows:

Effective immediately, the Fire Marshal is hereby directed to coordinate with the County to transition responsibility for the residential fire sprinkler plan check and inspection program within the District boundaries with a goal of full transition by October 1, 2019. The Fire Marshal is further directed to establish and charge a fee to ensure cost recovery for such services consistent with the District's current prevention fee rate schedule and in accordance with Section 1.8.4 of the California Residential Building Code.
