A. Letter from the El Dorado Hills Professional Firefighters – Chief Johnson explained that included in the packet was a letter from the El Dorado Hills Professional Firefighters stating that they would not support the annexation with Rescue Fire Protection District without matching the current staffing levels stated in the El Dorado Hills MOU.

#### IX. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- A. Administrative Committee (Directors Bennett and Hartley) Director Bennett stated that the Admin Committee met regarding the communications study and is waiting for more information before bringing the recommendation to the Board.
- **B.** Finance Committee (Directors Giraudo and White) No report.
- C. Joint Powers Authority (Directors Hartley and Giraudo) Chief Johnson reported that Brian Veerkamp and Christy Jorgensen are doing a great job and that the JPA opposed the County's proposed increase in the ambulance fee for service for vegetation management and the County agreed to slow that discussion down and take another look at it.
- **X. FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT** Chief Johnson reported the following to the Board:
  - Staff is prepared to file the notice of intent for the Rescue annexation.
  - The engineer's promotional exam went well and 6 people on the list
  - Nineteen applications were received for the Fire Marshall position and mid-December will be the target for the final interviews.
  - The Captain's academy is coming up in December.
  - El Dorado County was escalated to the purple tier and there and Staff will be looking at any adjustments that need to be made.
  - There are still discussions happening about the Santa run and holiday parties.

- The Amador Fire Chief is retiring and starting a new fire career in Nevada.
- Oakland Assistant Fire Chief passed away and Staff offers their condolences.

Operations Report (Receive and file) – Chief Hall stated that there was a lot of active shooter and water rescue training in November and recognized Chief Lilienthal's efforts to process the information related to the constant COVID-19 changes and the firefighter's efforts to stay safe in the current environment. 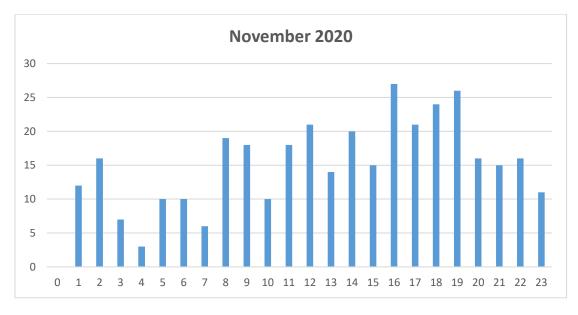

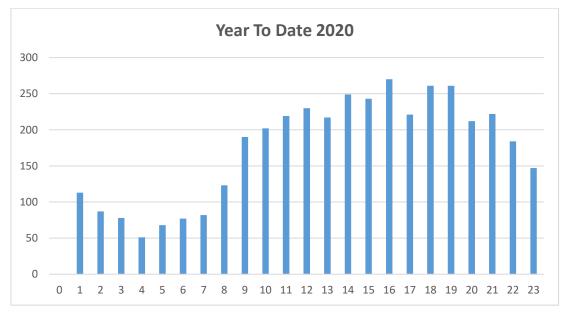

### Incidents by Hour of the Day

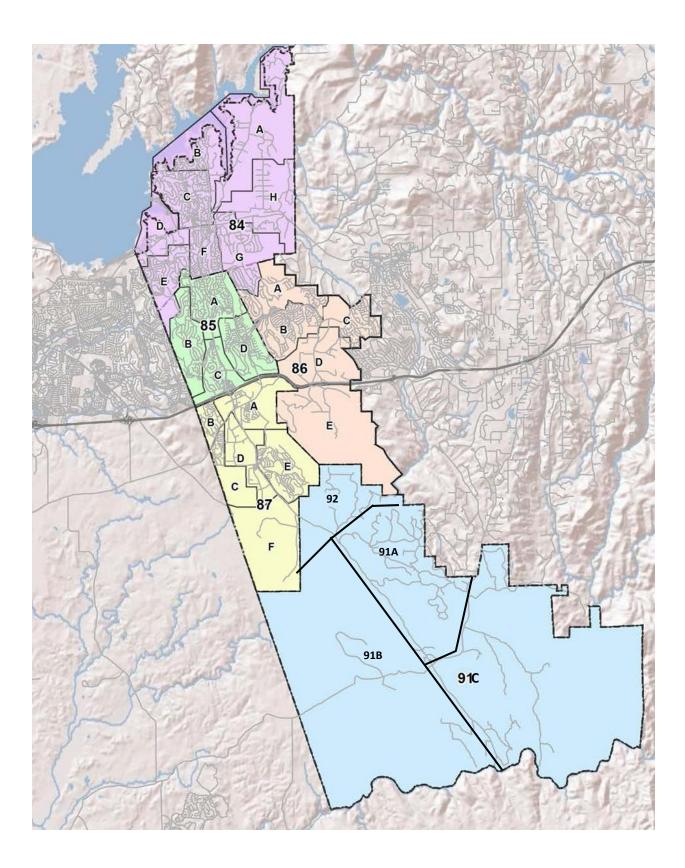

## December, 2020 Report

#### **OVERVIEW**

The El Dorado Hills Fire Department, Community Risk Reduction Division (CRRD) continues to see significant residential development and vegetation management program activity throughout the reporting period. Major construction activity occurred in the Saratoga Estates, Serrano, Carson Creek, Bell Ranch and Sienna Ridge areas of the District. The Town Center Apartment construction project continues to require significant staff commitment to review plans and complete construction inspections.

CRRD completed 4 defensible space inspections throughout the District. CRRD also investigated 7 Defensible Space citizen complaints on behalf of the County of El Dorado as part of their Vegetation Management program. CRRD also completed 1 fire & life safety inspections of schools, day care centers and other education facilities. We also completed 2 business license inspections in the last 30 days of businesses moving into existing commercial occupancies in the District. We continue to support the local business community, upon request, in response to COVID-19 business related changes to ensure that they do not conflict with fire safety regulations of the District.

#### **MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

CRRD staff completed the following activities during the last 30 days:

 Chief Johnson, the crew from Station 85 and CRRD staff were excited to present Amanda Rossi and Dean Kermani with their poster magnets for being selected as the top winners in the Department's "Serving Up Fire Safety in the Kitchen" Poster Contest.

- Assisted El Dorado County Fire Prevention Officers Association on a number of Fire Protection Standards updates and agreements.

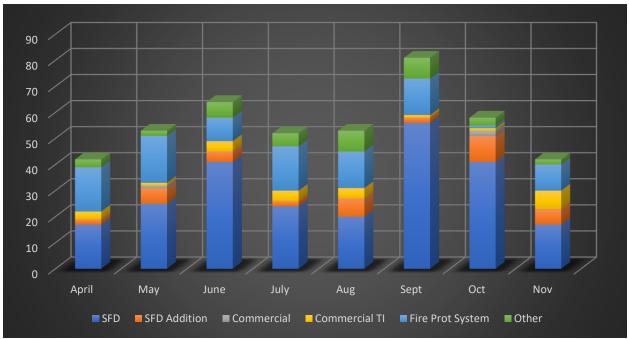


Table 1: New Construction Permit Activity by Month

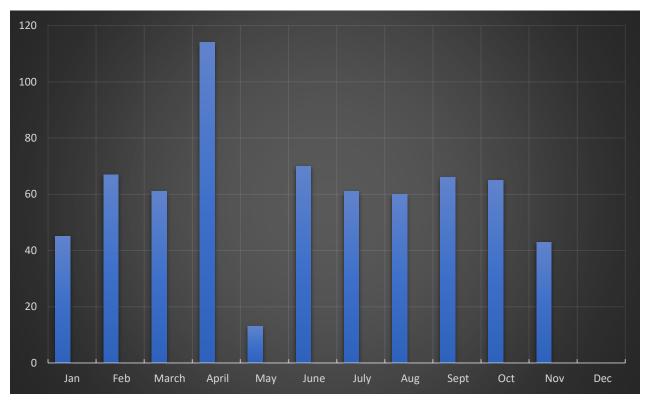


Table 2: Construction Plans Reviewed by Month Report

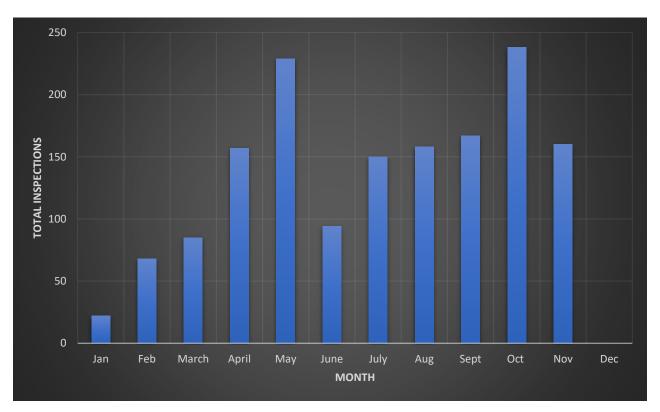


Table 3: Construction Inspections by Month Report

Side Letter Agreement #1 to the EDHPFF MOU.

#### SUMMARY

Staff seeks Board approval to adopt the proposed Side Letter Agreement #1 to the EDHPFF MOU.

#### DISCUSSION

The District's negotiating team met with 3604 representatives to discuss Section VI, Terms and Conditions of Employment, Subsection A., and also Section XIII, Union Leave, Subsection A. The proposed Side Letter Agreement #1 has been agreed upon by the EDHPFF, Local 3604, representatives and members by majority vote on November 16, 2020.

Below is the existing MOU language and also the amended language that outlines the changes that have been agreed upon in the proposed Side Letter Agreement #1.

1. Section VI, Terms and Conditions of Employment Subsection A.3 <u>current</u> wording:

Employees may be eligible for a step increase annually on or after their hire or promotional anniversary date.

# Section VI, Terms and Conditions of Employment Subsection A.3 <u>amended</u> wording:

Employees may be eligible for a step increase annually on or after their hire or promotional anniversary date. Firefighter/Paramedics hired between 2015 and 2018 may be eligible for a step increase on a date that is not their anniversary date due to Side Letter 2017-02 of the October 1, 2015 – September 30, 2019 MOU, in which salary step increases for steps 1-3 were awarded in six (6) month intervals.

 In section VI, Terms and Conditions of Employment, the verbiage in Subsections A.9. and A.10. were swapped in Side Letter Agreement #1.

# The new Section VI, Terms and Conditions of Employment Subsection A.9 <u>*current*</u> wording:

Constant Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) will be paid at a standard rate of three (3) hours per week at the employee's rate of pay, then multiplied by 1.5. Only employees assigned to a fifty-six (56) hour suppression schedule are eligible for Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) pay.

# The new Section VI, Terms and Conditions of Employment Subsection A.9 <u>amended</u> wording:

Only employees assigned to a fifty-six (56) hour suppression schedule are eligible for Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) pay.

#### 3. Section XIII, Union Leave, Subsection A *current* wording:

Both Union President and Vice President or a representative in their absence, will be given leave from duty to perform Department/Union related business. Such leave will only be granted if it does not disrupt the Departments operations. Total leave shall not exceed five hundred (500) hours per year.

#### Section XIII, Union Leave, Subsection A is *amended* to read as follows:

The Union President, Vice President and/or other Union designated representatives will be given leave from duty to perform Department/Union related business. Such leave will only be granted if it does not disrupt the Departments operations. Total leave shall not exceed five hundred (500) hours per year.

**THIS SIDE LETTER TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)** between the El Dorado Hills Professional Firefighters Local 3604 (EDHPFF) and representatives of the El Dorado Hills County Water District, alternatively referred to as El Dorado Hills Fire Department (Department), for the period of October 1, 2019 – June 30, 2023, referred to herein as **"Side Letter #1"**, is made and entered into and effective this 16<sup>th</sup> day of December 2020.

Section VI, <u>Terms and Conditions of Employment</u>, Subsection A., is hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. <u>Salaries</u>
  - 1. Captain/Paramedic base salary is formulated at four percent (4%) above a Captain base salary. An Engineer/Paramedic base salary is formulated at five percent (5%) above an Engineer base salary.
  - 2. Probationary Firefighter/Paramedics will remain at salary step 1 from date of hire until graduation from the Academy. Probationary Firefighter/Paramedics may be eligible to move to salary step 2 after graduation of the Academy and will remain at salary step 2 until completion of the probationary period. After completion of the probationary period, remaining salary step increases may be eligible annually on or after the anniversary date. At the discretion of the Fire Chief, lateral Probationary Firefighter/Paramedics may be hired at a salary step higher than salary step 1.
  - 3. Employees may be eligible for a step increase annually on or after their hire or promotional anniversary date. Firefighter/Paramedics hired between 2015 and 2018 may be eligible for a step increase on a date that is not their anniversary date due to Side Letter 2017-02 of the October 1, 2015 September 30, 2019 MOU, in which salary step increases for steps 1-3 were awarded in six (6) month intervals.
  - 4. An employee shall remain in a salary step for a period of one (1) year before being eligible to advance to the next step.
  - 5. If eligible for a step increase, the step increase will be effective the first day of the first full pay period after their eligibility date.
  - 6. A salary step increase is not an automatic payroll adjustment. Eligibility for a salary step increase will be based upon the employee's performance and length of service.
  - 7. Employees shall receive the following Cost of Living Adjustments:

a. Effective the first full pay period on or after October 1, 2019, employees shall receive a two percent (2%) increase to base salary. Reference the below salary schedule:

- b. Effective the first full pay period on or after July 1, 2020, employees shall receive a three percent (3%) increase to base salary. The salary schedule will be available at the time of this scheduled salary increase.
- c. Effective the first full pay period on or after July 1, 2021, employees shall receive a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase to base salary. The salary schedule will be available at the time of this scheduled salary increase.
- d. Effective the first full pay period on or after October 1, 2021, a one percent (1%) increase to base salary may be awarded to all ranks represented by the EDHPFF if growth in the El Dorado Hills Property Tax Revenue for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 exceeds five percent (5%). For the salary adjustment, the percent change in property tax revenue will be calculated using the actual property tax revenue for (FY) 2020-21 and the property tax revenue estimate provided by El Dorado County for (FY) 2021-22.
- e. Effective the first full pay period on or after July 1, 2022, employees shall receive a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase to base salary. The salary schedule will be available at the time of this scheduled increase.
- 8. No employee shall be involuntarily reassigned, through promotion, demotion or other action, to a forty (40) hour schedule.
- 9. Only employees assigned to a fifty-six (56) hour suppression schedule are eligible for Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) pay.

- 10. Any employee assigned to a forty (40) hour schedule (suppression or administrative) shall receive a twelve percent (12%) increase to their base hourly rate of pay. Employees who have been approved to work a light duty assignment are not eligible to receive the twelve percent (12%) increase to their base salary. The employee's rate of pay shall be calculated by multiplying the hourly rate of pay applicable to employees on a suppression shift schedule (*including the 12% increase, if applicable*) then multiplying this number by 1.4.
- 11. The following is the formula for converting fifty-six (56) hour position leave to forty (40) hour position leave:

Hours on books divided by 1.4 = Converted Time; The same formula will be used to calculate accrual rates.

12. The following is the formula for converting forty (40) hour position leave to fiftysix (56) hour position leave:

> Hours on books multiplied by 1.4 = Converted Time; The same formula will be used to calculate accrual rates.

Section XIII, Union Leave, Subsection A., is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The Union President, Vice President and/or other Union designated representatives will be given leave from duty to perform Department/Union related business. Such leave will only be granted if it does not disrupt the Departments operations. Total leave shall not exceed five hundred (500) hours per year.
