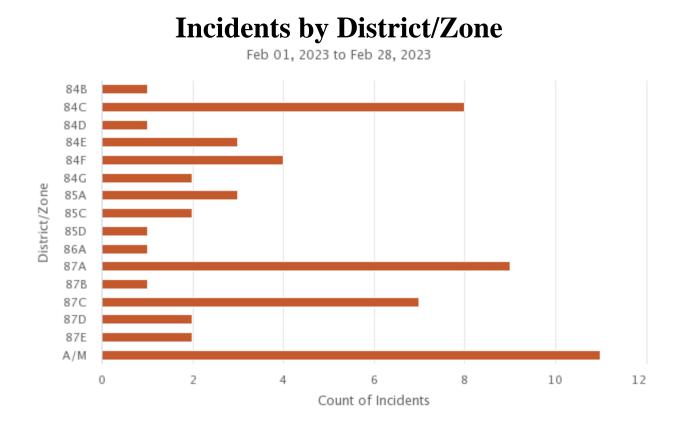
Operations

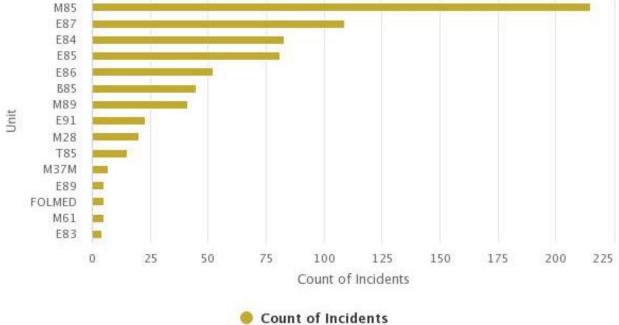

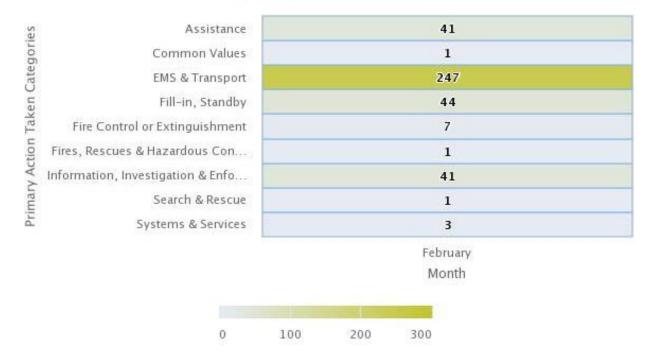
Response by Unit (Top 15 Resources)





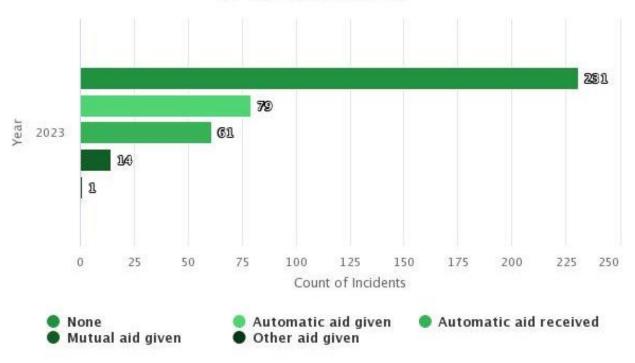

February 2023 Report

OVERVIEW

The El Dorado Hills Fire Department, Community Risk Reduction Division (CRRD) continues to see significant residential development and vegetation management program activity throughout the reporting period. Major construction activity continues in the Saratoga Estates, Carson Creek, Bell Ranch, Hawk View, and Bass Lake North areas of the District. New project proposals consisting of Project Frontier industrial shipping and receiving at Latrobe, Town & Country Village conference and hotel facilities at Bass Lake Road, Montano retail and hotel development at White Rock Rd. & Latrobe Rd., Quantam Care Residential Care Facility at Carson Crossing , and Costco at Silva Valley are ongoing. New commercial construction consisting of El Dorado Irrigation District (EID) Wastewater Facility, Tractor Supply in the Business Park area, Aloft Hotel in Town Center, as well as the training center continues to progress.

CRRD new construction inspection and plan review has remained relatively steady. As CRRD is implementing automatic reporting through the electronic plan review system and data validation remains ongoing, updated new construction statistics will be forthcoming.

CRRD investigated **9** Defensible Space re-inspections on behalf of the County of El Dorado as part of their Vegetation Management program. With winter weather reducing mitigation capability, Defensible Space Inspectors focused on preparing education and notification materials for the upcoming season.

CRRD completed **111** inspections of smoke alarm and carbon monoxide alarm installations with an approximately 17% failure rate. As smoke alarms have been demonstrated to safe lives and property, these inspections are in invaluable part of the CRRD service to the community.

MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

CRRD staff completed the following activities during the last 30 days:

- Completed **134** construction inspections and **111** smoke and carbon monoxide alarm inspections.
- Completed **38** fire and life safety inspections of residential and commercial occupancies.
- Completed **9** defensible space complaint inspections.
- Implemented new plan intake and plan review records management systems (RMS) to improve customer satisfaction and streamlining permit processes.

SUBJECT: Training Captain Vehicle Conversion

TOPIC

Staff seeks Board authorization to purchase a Training Captain vehicle conversion.

SUMMARY

At a February 16, 2023, Special Board Meeting, the Board of Directors authorized the purchase of a replacement Training Captain vehicle directly from a local dealership.

Staff has evaluated the need for this command vehicle conversion, as well as the available options and post-purchase customer service of potential vendors. Staff also considered the need for consistency with operational standards relative to the functionality of its vehicles, including future maintenance of the new technology available. Staff determined that 911 Vehicle, which is currently the vendor contracted to build the Department's Battalion Chief and the two (2) Deputy Chief vehicle conversions would be the best vendor to select for the conversion of the Training Captain vehicle as well.

Consistent with the District's procurement policy, we are able to utilize an existing public contract with Sourcewell, National Auto Fleet Group, which went through a competitive bid process for the same type of vehicle build. The Sourcewell master vehicle contract that is being utilized is contract number 091521-NAF.

FISCAL IMPACT

Because this vehicle was not scheduled to be replaced until 2025, it was not included in the 2022-23 fiscal year budget. Therefore, the conversion of the vehicle will result in a capital budget variance and will need to be adjusted accordingly in the mid-year budget.
